
Access the Download

Once your order is complete, there are three ways to access your download:

- I. From the Order Success page
- 2. From your "My Account Downloads" page
- 3. From the Order email

1. From the Order Success Page

Click the "click here to visit 'My Downloads' link



Continue with the steps for "My Downloads" in the next option...

2. From your "My Account - Downloads" page



This can be accessed by clicking "My Account" from any store page, and logging in:



This takes you to "My Dashboard", then select "My Downloads" from the menu on the left:



My Downloads

You should now see a page like this:



Notice the "Remaining Downloads" – this starts at 5 for everything except the PDF Songbook. To get your download – click the link under "Click to Download" – in this case "Jesus doesn't change Full Track MP3 File"

What happens now will depend on your "Default Browser": <u>Internet Explorer</u>, <u>Chrome</u> or <u>Firefox</u> (other browsers are similar):

Internet Explorer 9 Browser


A box will appear at the bottom of the screen with download choices, don't choose "open", do choose "save":



The download will happen, and the box will be replaced with another: Choose "Open Folder" to see where your download is:




The folder will be shown, and you can access your download file:




Google Chrome Browser

This will show a "Save As" Dialog - choose the folder where you want your file to go, and click "Save"



Firefox Browser

This will show an "Open File" Dialog – be careful: you don't want to open the file, you want to save it!




Make sure the "Save File" choice is selected




I also recommend that you don't select the "Do this automatically box" Click "OK", and then either:


- (a) The file will download to your default download folder, or
- (b) You will be given a choice where to save it:




In either case, Firefox will show it's downloads window:



Right-Click the filename to get a dropdown menu, and select "Open Containing Folder"



Now you'll see your file, in the folder where you saved it:



3. From your Order Email

There will be a "download" link next to the file name - click it:



You will be taken to your default browser.

If you are logged in to your MGBT store account, the link will go straight to the download – and you can follow the instructions per browser above.

If you are not logged in, the link will take you to "My Downloads" – and you can follow the instructions above.

Use your Download

Your Download will be one of three types, a PDF file, an MP3 file, or a ZIP file

1. PDF File

Double click the file, and Adobe Reader should open it. If you do not have Adobe Reader installed, use this link to get it free:

http://get.adobe.com/reader/

NB: Un-tick whatever other software they offer – it's not needed.


2. MP3 File

Double click the file, and your media player should play it.


3. ZIP File

This will need "Extracting" - Windows 7 can do this for you:

View your file in its folder, and right-click it: a menu will appear, and one of the options will be "Extract All" – choose this.



Another dialog appears - where would you like to save your file?



Choose a destination, and click "Extract", your files will appear in the location you chose.

Special Notes for iThing users

The iPad / iPhone doesn't like you downloading MP3 or ZIP files. This leaves you with three options:

- Use your home computer to download the files, copy them to iTunes, then sync to your iThing
- Install a "download manager" app on your iThing, and see if that can cope with the download. (You'll have to use a search engine to find a "download manager" e.g. Google)
